

Art Students Win Prizes

Pupils of the Philadelphia School of Design for Women have carried off nine prizes in the annual competitive exhibition of art students' work, now being held on Chestnut street. Eight money prizes have been awarded to pupils still members of its classes, and one other to a graduate of 1909, Susette I. Schultz. The first prize for water color, \$50, is won by Marguerite De Krafft, the second of \$25 by Elizabeth Schwarz, and three minor prizes of \$10 each by Clara V. Richardson, Gertrude Moore and Theresa Bernstein. In oils also Miss Bernstein won a \$10 prize, as did also Leah Ramsay, while Ruth Smith won the second prize for oils, \$25.
